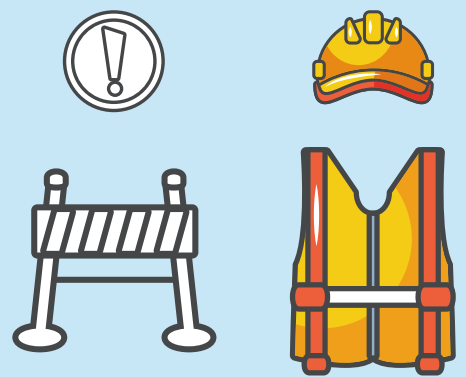
**Occupational Safety
